

### What is Operators Training Course (OTC)?

Operators Training Course (OTC) is an essential part of the wider training process developed in the scope of the Circular 4.0 project to assist acceleration of SME's towards circular economy (CE). It aims to enable the operators (i.e. business support organisations, intermediary organization, local networks and association, service providers and local public authorities etc.) of the Circularity Acceleration Training courses 4.0 to actually implement them at the level of individual regions of the Alpine Space, taking into account the actual needs of the SMEs in each particular region. The OTC is implemented in each region to attune the Circularity Acceleration Training course 4.0 to the needs of the SMEs in their respective environment (region, country). This way the transformation processes in participating SMEs can be effective and can result in an increase in circular business model potential and in their commitments to the circular transformation.

OTC was developed in the scope of the Circular 4.0 project under the activity A.T2.1. Identification of the users training needs and A.T2.3. Setting up the toolkit to strengthen CE with digitalisation process and it will be implemented within this OTC - Local training action addressed to intermediaries and service providers (D.T2.2.3)

### What is Circular Acceleration Training 4.0 (CAT4.0)?

Circularity Acceleration Training course 4.0 (CAT4.0) is a pluri-modular training course designed for SMEs to be delivered by the operators across the Alpine Space. The CAT4.0 is designed to steer and facilitate the circular transformation, centred on the redesign of business models from linear to circular by the deployment and maturation of the use of digital technologies.

CAT4.0 was developed in the scope of the Circular 4.0 project under the activity A.T2.1. Identification of the users training needs and A.T2.3. Setting up the toolkit to strengthen CE with digitalisation process and it will be implemented within this CAT4.0 - Local action to implement CE Design Model approaches with digitalisation processes (D.T3.2.1) and Local actions to implement CE Optimal Use approaches with digitalisation processes (D.T3.2.2).









### Operators Training Course (OTC) organisation

#### Language of the course

OTC will be organised in **English** to be available for more broader audience within the Alpine Space macro region. **The course was developed and upgraded in the scope of the Circular 4.0 project within the Interreg Alpine Space programme by project partners and circular economy experts. Subsequent sessions of the OTC may be held in other local languages, according to the needs of the participants attending the training to become operators of the <b>training process** based on the CIRCULAR4.0 project training guidelines.

#### Participants of the OTC

Participants will be invited by CIRCULAR4.0 project partners from services providers/intermediaries such as technology parks, business incubators, business accelerators, public funding organisations, industrial clusters, innovation agencies and other business support agencies and intermediaries from public and affiliated private sectors with a mandate to assist with business development.

#### Participants of the CAT4.0

Participants of the CAT4.0 are micro, small and medium size enterprises (SMEs) i.e. entrepreneurs, top management/business decision makers and HR managers.

#### **Course Delivery format**

Course delivery will be organised in a "hybrid mode", using an on-line learning platform (TalentLMS - publicly available and operated by JSI) and Zoom for live sessions. The latter ones may be carried out also in a classroom, should the circumstances allow. Access to the on-line training course will be available to all participants of the OTC prior to the course.

#### Materials of the training

Materials for the next session will be available ahead of the time so participants have the chance to prepare if they wish even if it is not required.


